Comprehensive support for vulnerable categories

Project «Strengthening Communities for Child Well-Being»

In 2024, we continued our cooperation with UNICEF and are successfully implementing a project aimed at supporting children and their families, as well as promoting adoption and family forms of upbringing.

The project «Strengthening **Communities for Child Well-Being**» is implemented by «Ridni» Charitable Foundation tin cooperation with **UNICEF** with financial support from the United States Agency for International Development (USAID), the people of Japan, the German Federal Ministry for Economic **Cooperation and Development (BMZ)** through the state development bank KfW, the Austrian Development Agency (ADA) and the Government of France.



Within the joint project, we worked in five areas:

- Psychosocial support for children, adolescents and their parents
- Psychosocial support for families from vulnerable categories of the population
- Promotion and creation
 of alternative forms of family upbringing
- Strengthening the child protection system at the regional and ommunity level
- Involvement in the Reintegration program (return of children from abroad)

The project covered five regions within the western region:

- Lviv
- Chernivtsi
- Zakarpattia
- Ivano-Frankivsk
- Volyn

In Uzhhorod, we held the Forum «With a child, for a child, for the sake of a child», dedicated to ensuring the best interests of every child and the development of family forms of upbringing, which was attended by more than 150 participants.

We conducted 7 events

where we increased the capacity of specialists in implementing the «Better Care for Children» reform at the community and regional levels. **We reached more than 150 specialists.**

We conducted over 19 trainings

for specialists on providing quality social services, **covering more than 400 participants.**



Project «Strengthening Communities for Child Well-Being»

We recorded 12 new podcast episodes

where invited guests, parents who adopted children into their families shared their own experiences, and also discussed with our specialists - a lawyer and a psychologist interesting and relevant issues regarding adoption and family forms of upbringing.

The podcast episode with Tetiana Perevezentseva

«Childhood in an institution. How do institutions affect the formation of a child's personality?» **was included in the weekly selection of the best podcasts from NV media.** We launched an outdoor advertising campaign aimed at raising awareness about adoption and family forms of upbringing,

in Lviv and Zakarpattia regions.

498 129 people

were reached by the media campaign on the topic of adoption and family forms of upbringing.

The Forum «With a child, for a child, for the sake of a child» dedicated to ensuring the best interests of every child and the development of family forms of upbringing took place in Uzhhorod.

150 participants took part in it, including representatives of state and local government bodies, specialists from children's affairs services and social services, communities of Zakarpattia region, representatives of charitable and public organizations.







The forum became a platform for exchanging experience and developing practical solutions that will help protect children's rights, especially during the war, as well as ensure their right to be raised in a family. Through interaction

and exchange of best practices, we aim to contribute to increasing the capacity of communities for the development of family forms of upbringing: guardianship and care, foster families, family-type children's homes.



The Forum «Child. Dream. Family» dedicated to ensuring every child's right to grow up in a family environment took place in Lviv.



More than 200 representatives of state authorities and local selfgovernment, specialists in children's affairs services, foster parents and other interested persons united to discuss ensuring every child's right to grow up in a of every child, the development family environment.

The forum took a comprehensive approach to issues that arise in the implementation of state policy and sectoral regional programs regarding the provision of measures to protect the rights

of a developed system of family forms of upbringing for orphans and children deprived of parental care, as well as the development of services to support parents or persons who replace them.

Our partners from **«The Ambassador Platform»** provided scholarships that allowed eight residents to receive additional training, extended medical support, technical assistance for the educational process, as well as provision of clothing and personal hygiene products.

MI Center for Social Support of Children and Families «Ridni» LCC

MI Center for Social Support of Children and Families «Ridni» LCC was created by the Children's Affairs Service of the Lviv City Council in partnership with «Ridni» Charitable Foundation. The foundation provided a fully equipped facility with renovation. The main goal of the MI Center «Ridni» LCC is to preserve the family and return the child to relatives.



It is here that up to 26 children can temporarily live. Among them are children who have been left without parental care, orphans and children who are in difficult life circumstances.
The Center has two departments: **«Urgent Placement of Children» and «Family Support Service».**

Family-type children's homes (FTCH)

Since 2016, the Foundation has been can live in each of them, including taking care of two family-type children's homes in Lviv created in partnership with the Children's Affairs Service of the LCC. Up to 10 children

orphans and children deprived of parental care. They receive everything necessary for safe development, as well as comprehensive support (education, career guidance, health improvement).

Thanks to the care of parenteducators, children live in a warm family atmosphere where everyone feels needed and protected.

Support for FTCH graduate

Our foundation became part of an important event in the life of Lilia Hnatyo - a graduate of a family-type children's home. With the support of the Lviv City Council and our foundation, Liliia was able to purchase her first apartment.











Within the framework of the city's targeted program for co-financing the purchase of housing for orphans, children deprived of parental care, and persons from among them, the Lviv City Council provided about 70% of

the cost of housing, and the rest was covered by our foundation. Thanks to joint efforts, we were able to make this important step for Liliia a reality.

Project goal:

preserving and increasing the potential of families in crisis situations to ensure the wellbeing of children in Ukraine by supporting the capacity and scaling the work of the «Family Support Service» department of the «Ridni» Center, promoting recommendations and cross-sectoral cooperation on preserving the family and returning the child to relatives at the legislative and social levels.



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The project is implemented within the «Family Support Service» department of MI «Center for Social Support of Children and Families «Ridni» LCC. Activities are aimed at helping families who have found themselves in difficult life circumstances to ensure the preservation of the family for the well-being of the child. The project provides:

strengthening the department's team with additional specialists

opromoting cross-sectoral cooperation

development of methodological recommendations for the activities of MI «Center for Social Support of Children and Families «Ridni» LCC



Project participants were families from the Lviv territorial community who need additional support from psychosocial specialists: family-type children's homes, foster and guardian families, adoptive families, patronage families, biological families in difficult life circumstances, families raising children with disabilities and/or special educational needs, families with IDP status.

Total number of psychological consultations > 200

The following activities were conducted by specialized specialists (correctional psychologist, neuropsychologist, art trainer, speech therapistdefectologist)

period from July 2024 to December 2024 inclusive:

The topics of the events were dedicated to overcoming stress, relationships between parents and ecological interaction and revealing family resources.

family consultations: 58

individual consultations: 813

group consultations: 39 (including 2 workshops and 10 art therapy sessions with children and adults)

Group events help improve children, promote the development of skills of awareness of one's own needs and emotional self-regulation of parents/persons who replace them.

The result of the work was motivation for positive changes in family interaction and strengthening family ties among workshop participants, art therapy and group sessions.





In 2024, the project covered psychosocial services for 84 families with 144 children:

On November 7, 2024, the Forum «When are we going home?» was held, the purpose of which was a comprehensive discussion of urgent issues related to providing support to children and families who found themselves in crisis life situations; participants analyzed the needs of a child and their family, looked for effective solutions for reintegrating children into families or upbringing in alternative family forms.



forum held The was simultaneously in two formats offline and online, which made it possible for a larger number of participants from all over Ukraine to join. The event gathered more than 180 participants, including representatives of local selfgovernment bodies, specialists from children's affairs services from different regions, social work specialist and representatives of public organizations.



The event took place within the framework of the project «Strengthening the capacity of the «Family Support Service» department of the «Ridni» Center», which is implemented by CF «Ridni» in cooperation with the Department «Children's Affairs Service» of the LCC and MI «Center for Social Support of Children and Families «Ridni» LCC» with the support of the Government of Great Britain.

Mental health and psychosocial support for children and adults (MHPSS)

Project «Resilience Resources in Educational Communities» supported by World Vision

The «Ridni» Charitable Foundation joined the portfolio of verified partners of World Vision International and with the support of World Vision Ukraine Crisis Response in 2024 began implementing the project «Resilience Resources in Educational Communities», which aims to adapt and strengthen the psychological resilience of children and families affected by war.



What makes this project unique?

It helps develop competencies and strengthen the capacity of social workers, psychologists and teachers of general secondary education institutions to create a safe environment for children and families.

It promotes the improvement of the psychoemotional state of children and families through interaction with resource methodologies with the assistance of specialists.

The project consists of several sequential stages and will be implemented in 2025 in Lviv and Dnipro.



- Conducting two resource-educational forums «Points of Support» in Lviv and Dnipro
- Online training course on working with the methodological set «Khvylyalka» and practical part for implementing the tool in work
 - Online workshop on writing therapeutic fairy tales
- Writing of therapeutic fairy tales by participants and creation of an illustrated collection

Organization and conducting of training courses on the methodology of working with the psychological



In 2024, 60 participants completed the course, including psychologists, educators and social workers from different regions. Three offline and two online courses were conducted.

Collaboration with Lviv BookForum literary festival

Within the 31st International Literary Festival Lviv BookForum, CF «Ridni» organized and conducted special events aimed at sharing the experience of psychological support for children through fairy tale therapy. It was a great opportunity to get acquainted with our activities and learn how fairy tales help children and adults overcome difficult life situations.







Panel discussion on the topic: «Fairy tales for children or adults: who needs them more?»

The participants of the discussion psychologist Svitlana Omelnytska, writer Dara Kornii and the editorinchief of «Magula» publishing house Nadiia Zhyla - discussed the relevance of fairy tales from the point of view of psychological demand, creative selfexpression and market demand in the conditions of modern Ukraine.

Lecture on the topic: «Recovery through fairy tales: a source of strength for family interaction»

Fairy tale therapist Svitlana Omelnytska shared tools that help enrich the experience of reading and listening to fairy tales, providing additional resources for both children and adults.



Trainings implemented in partnership with UNICEF

«Parental Amulet»



Training was conducted for specialists to improve parental competencies. Methodological material was finalized: «Parental Amulet» manual + «The Hedgehog Who Was Found». An electronic collection of fairy tales about Khvylyalka was created based on fairy tales written by participants during the training.

«Non-violent communication when working with families in difficult life circumstances»



Trainings were conducted to form participants knowledge and skills on conflict resolution through mechanisms of non-violent communication for further work with families who found themselves in difficult life circumstances. We managed to reach 67 participants from Zakarpattia region.

«Socio-sychological technology of child adaptation in a new family according to the «Helper Hedgehog» methodology»



Trainings were conducted to increase the knowledge and skills of specialists from children's affairs services in working with children adapting to new family conditions.

53 specialists from Zakarpattia region were covered.

«Therapeutic Hedgehog»



We conducted a series of trainings to help participants master knowledge and skills in working with children using toys («Therapeutic Hedgehog - Mother and Baby»). The trainings are aimed at developing sustainable behavioral strategies of resilience in war conditions and providing psychosocial support.

We covered 120 participants from Zakarpattia region.

All-Ukrainian art festival «Create Worlds»

The «Ridni» Charitable Foundation created and organized a creative project - the All-Ukrainian art festival «Create Worlds» for children from vulnerable categories: orphans,

children deprived of parental care, those in difficult life circumstances, as well as those affected by the war.



The art festival became a safe platform for children, where they were able to express themselves emotionally, develop innate creativity and explore the world. Events were conducted in the format of art workshops covering various artistic directions.





In 2024, the project was implemented in

Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Cherkasy and Kharkiv regions. We managed to involve about 500 children.

Thanks to various forms of interaction in the creative process with specialists and other children, participants received the necessary resources and experience of creative expression to strengthen internal supports against difficult life situations and challenges of the full-scale invasion for the sake of a happy future for Ukraine.

 The non-formal education program «Spilnota» is a project aimed at supporting teenagers from vulnerable categories.

The goal of the program is to create a safe space where teenagers can receive psychological, social and emotional support, develop life skills and adapt to wartime conditions. Within the program, master classes, trainings, practical exercises, meetings, events and field trips are conducted, which help participants improve emotional management and reduce levels of stress and anxiety.



Thanks to the support of Ukraine Children's Action Project, we managed to involve 167 teenagers from Lviv, 31 teenagers from Dnipro in the program, who received knowledge in career guidance, non-formal education and psychological support. Thanks to the partner The Collectyv in Kyiv region, 60 teenagers were involved who went through the program in Fastiv and Hrebinky for three months.













Partners Avalon, Vchasno, Ukrenergo joined the formation of the program, providing the program with lectures, workshops and excursions with the possibility of internships. Main directions of the program: psychological, career guidance and educational support for teenagers and youth from 14 to 23 years old.





The program is implemented in Lviv, Kyiv and Ivano-Frankivsk, previously also operated in Dnipro. In December 2024, a program for teenagers and youth in Ivano-Frankivsk began with the support of Ukraine Children's Action Project, where, in addition to non-formal education, teenagers have the opportunity to receive educational support for admission to higher educational institutions.

Children's camps

A summer camp was held for children from MI «Center for Social Support of Children and Families «Ridni» of the Lviv City Council. The camp took place in the village of Strilky, Sambir district. Children received powerful educational and patriotic experience: they learned to be leaders, support each other, act cohesively and take responsibility.









The main goal of the camp is to create an opportunity for children to spend time fun, informative and safe, gain valuable experience, find new friends and create memories that will stay with them for life.

Football camp organized by the «Orphans Care Center» with financial support from «Beetroot» company

22 young men from vulnerable categories took part in a football camp, which became not only a sports gathering, but also part of a comprehensive program of psychoemotional recovery. During the week, participants overcame the consequences of stress. strengthened emotional resilience, restored socialization skills through team interaction and psychological support, and prepared for the football championship.





The camp program combined daily intensive training with psychological support, helping young men reduce anxiety, strengthen self-confidence and prepare for competitions. Teamwork developed trust and cohesion. In addition to physical training, participants went through group sessions with psychologists, which contributed to a better understanding of their emotions and overcoming traumatic experiences. As a result, the young men became more open, confident and ready for challenges both on the field and in life.





We thank our partners for supporting this initiative, which helps children who have experienced difficult life circumstances find new opportunities for development and look confidently to the future.

A special proof of the effectiveness of the camp was the team's participation in the «Hope for Mundial» championship, where they won third place among 24 teams. They also took part in the «Silver Liga», which was organized by the association of amateur mini-football teams of Lviv region and took first place. These results became not only a sporting success, but also a symbol of personal growth and cohesion.
